- **Teilnahmevoraussetzungen:**

Teammitglieder: Teilnahmeberechtigt sind eingeschriebene Studierende. Kein spezifisches Vorwissen in Eisbildhauerei ist erforderlich, jedoch ist Interesse an Kunst und Design wünschenswert (insbesondere für Studierende aus gestaltungsnahen Studiengängen).

Teamleiter: Der Teamleiter muss über einen Master-Abschluss oder einen höheren Abschluss in einem mit Design verbundenen Bereich verfügen. Die Teilnahme ist unabhängig vom Alter möglich.

Dieses Programm ist für Teilnehmer anderer Länder gedacht. Personen mit chinesischer Staatsangehörigkeit können sich daher leider nicht bewerben.

Teilnehmer mit deutscher Staatsbürgerschaft benötigen kein Visum für China.

4TH TO 7TH JANUARY, 2025
HARBIN, CHINA

The 17th International Collegiate Snow Sculpture Contest (ICSSC 2025) will be held in HEU from 4th to 7th January, 2025, organized by National Instructive Committee of Industrial Design Education, Ministry of Education of China, and hosted by Harbin Engineering University (HEU). This event is aimed to popularize the ice and snow culture, promote the communication among global students, enable the experience of local Harbin culture and tradition, demonstrate and show the creative competencies of college students, and construct the communication and exchange platform for collegiate students. For each institution, only one team is expected.

6 REGISTRATION AND ARRANGEMENT

1. Registration materials

i. Please fill in the “17th International Collegiate Snow Sculpture Contest (ICSSC 2025) Team Enrollment Form” and name it by “Application Form_University Name” ;

ii. Please provide an A4 size sketch or sculpture model photos (two photos of different angles) in the format of .jpeg within 3MB in storage size, with the two photos named by “Draft-design_University Name_Sculpture Name (translation into Chinese by HEU)” ; and provide a brief description of the design within 200 words in the format of Word(.doc/docx);

iii. Please provide a picture of university logo within 3MB in the format of .jpeg, and the background should be white or transparent, and please name the picture by “University logo_University Name” ;

iv. Please provide a group photo of team members with the background of the front gate, or landmark, of the university or college, within 3MB in jpeg, named by “Team Photo_University Name” ;

v. Please provide one-inch photos of each coach and team member with the size of 27mm×38mm and a resolution of no less than 150dpi, named by “University Name_Coach/Team Member_Name” .

7 RULES OF CONTEST

1. The contest consists of professional contest and amateur contest.

In professional contest, each team, consists of 4 members, will be provided with a standard snow block (3m. in width, 3m. in height and 3m. in length).

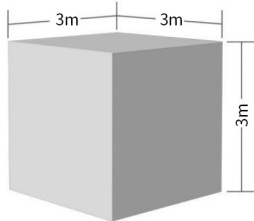


Figure 1. Standard Snow Block

In amateur contest, each team, consists of 3 members, will be provided with a small snow block (1.5m. in width, 1.5m. in height and 1m. in length).

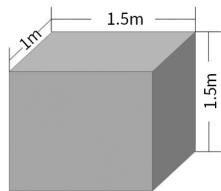
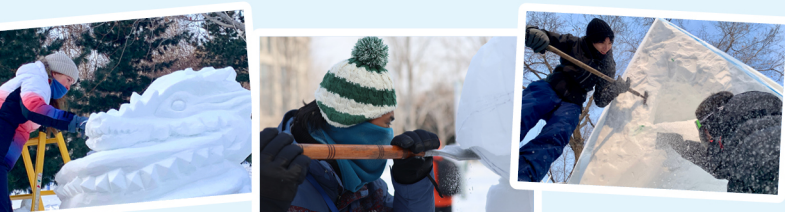


Figure 2. Small Snow Block

Each team could only attend one kind of contest, professional or amateur.



2. Please consider the factors such as work load and weather when selecting team members. Once the contest begins, no team member is allowed to be changed. Any special conditions needing adjustment on leading staff, please contact the secretariat of the contest.
3. Works participated should be your original designs. Plagiarism is prohibited, and it will lead to disqualification of committed teams.
4. The block of snow should be sculpted on all four sides. No colorants, electric tools or precision measuring instruments can be used. No supports may be used in or on the final sculptures. No waste residue snow is allowed within the scope of 1 meter of the snow works.
5. Working time of the contest is from 7:00 to 21:00 every day.
6. The host will provide a ladder for each team. The teams are suggested to prepare tools by themselves. If they need tools from the host, please specify in the registration form.
7. Once the contest begins, any change of the original design is prohibited without the committee's permission.
8. The organizers have the final right of interpretation to the competition.



8 CRITERIA OF EVALUATION

1. Theme and Ideas (10')
2. Creativity and Innovation (20')
3. Difficulty (25')
4. Skills and Performance (25')
5. Artistic expression (20')

1. No fees for attending the contest will be charged.
2. Catering and accommodation during the Contest (3rd to 8th January, 2025) will be provided by HEU.
